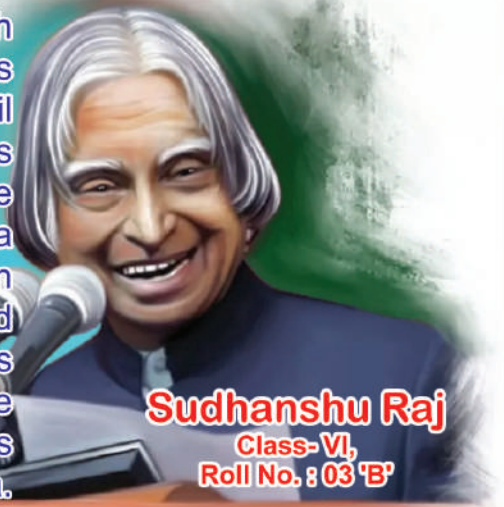

Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam

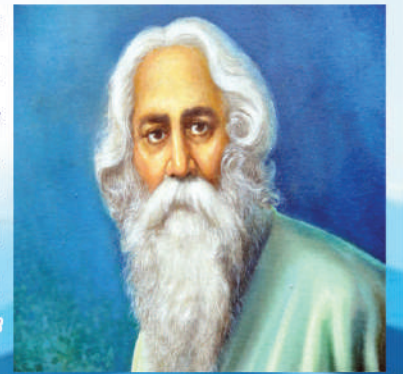
